Primary School Children's Story/Coloring Book Literacy Project - Africa

In response to COVID-19 and in preparation for the next threats to education in Africa, African Orphan Educational Foundation is overseeing a collaboration of local artists to illustrate a children's story/coloring book for the benefit of the orphans and disadvantaged children whose education and personal development we champion.

The children we serve come from humble homes without running water or electricity, nor reliable internet connections or devices enabling them to connect to educational resources when schools are closed. With pandemic school closures deepening the educational crisis in the sub-Saharan Africa region, and no reliable back-up plan for remote learning in advance of the next pandemic, the opportunity to provide supplemental learning and literacy materials is evident.

The inspiration for a children's story/coloring book sprang from a meeting of our youth volunteers who saw how African children covet just one page torn from a coloring book when mission groups travel through their villages. Our sponsored children and their siblings in these no-tech and low-tech communities will benefit from a literacy project presented in coloring book form.

A collaboration provides the opportunity for an entire creative community to unite for the common good of Africa's children. Artistic expression and appreciation, which have long enriched our local Palm Beach County culture, can be shared to the delight and educational advancement of those less advantaged.
