Our focus on education and long-standing partnerships with U.S.-based mission/aid agencies in Kenya and Uganda allow us to produce impact that is direct, long-lasting, and multi-generational. We have awarded 112 annual educational sponsorships in Kenya and Uganda since our inception in 2019. We and members of our team live in or travel regularly to the villages and informal settlements in which our students reside. Despite big achievements, we remain a small nonprofit organization, still paying out-of-pocket for our own travel expenses.
